UK / JOHANNESBURG / PORT ELIZABETH – Overnight Flight:

Depart on an overnight flight to Port Elizabeth via Johannesburg, arriving early afternoon the following day. Having cleared your luggage, collect your hire car and drive to your preferred Big Five game lodge.

AIRPORT / SAFARI – 2 Nights:

With its wide diversity of natural habitats, the Eastern Cape caters for all tastes and budgets. The Eastern Cape is home to various nature reserves, marine reserves and game parks, where a wide variety of fauna and flora can be found. It is a malaria free area, making it the perfect safari destination for both a first-time safari experience as well as return visitors (and especially for families). The area supports prolific birdlife; and game includes, among many others, the Big 5 (elephant, lion, leopard, rhino and buffalo)

PLETTENBERG BAY / WILDERNESS ([GARDEN ROUTE](#)) – 2 Nights:

The Western Garden Route encompasses fresh water lakes, lagoons, forests, the towering peaks of the Outinequa Mountains and miles of beautiful beaches. The area is a Garden of Eden; home to the Knysna elephant, the Knysna seahorse, Knysna dwarf chameleon, the brilliantly coloured Knysna Loerie, the Wilderness National Park, the Map of Africa, the Outinequa Power Van and much more.

WILDERNESS / ROBERTSON (BREEDE RIVER VALLEY) – 2 Night:

There really is no adjective apt enough to describe the beauty of the **Breede River Valley**. This incredibly picturesque fruit and wine producing valley is littered with wine producing vines due in no small part to the hot climate that is perfect for fortified desert wines like Hanepoot and Muscadel in particular. More than 50 wine estates are incorporated into various wine routes within the valley as well as a Brandy route as a result, and the relatively new and extremely popular Route 62, marketed as the longest wine route in the world, makes its way through the valley to the Klein Karoo too.

ROBERTSON / FRANSCHHOEK (WINELANDS) – 2 Nights:

The Cape Winelands is a region of the Western Cape Province of South Africa. The fertile green valleys of the Cape Winelands are surrounded by proud mountain ranges and it is the largest wine producing region in South Africa and is divided into six main wine regions, each offering its own unique wine route. Constantia, Stellenbosch, Franschhoek, Paarl, Robertson and Wellington are the most popular

Visit Simons Town, a haven for visitors interested in maritime history. Visit the statue of Able Seaman Just Nuisance and hear the story of this legendary Great Dane (and friend); Kirstenbosch Botanical gardens is a must for every visitor to Cape Town and is a haven for lovers of nature, flora and fauna.
